

SUPPORT FOR YOU IN STAFFORDSHIRE MOORLANDS DURING THE COVID-19 OUTBREAK



On 23 March 2020, the Prime Minister addressed the nation and instructed the British people to stay at home to help us fight the outbreak of the Covid-19 coronavirus.

The Government has had to taken extraordinary measures to keep us safe. Unless we get the virus under control, then it could overwhelm all of our vital services and cause much greater loss of life.

You should only leave the house for one of four reasons.

- Shopping for basic necessities, food and medicine and only as infrequently as possible.
- 2. One form of exercise a day: a run, walk or cycle alone or with members of your household.
- 3. Any medical need, or to provide care or to help a vulnerable person.
- 4. Travelling to and from work, but only where this absolutely cannot be done from home.

These four reasons are exceptions.

Minimise the time you spend outside your home. When you are outside ensure you are 2 metres apart from anyone outside of your household.

All of us must comply with these new measures. The relevant authorities, including the police, have been given powers to enforce them - possibly through fines and by dispersing gatherings. The Government will look regularly at these measures and relax them if the evidence shows this is possible.

These rules have been introduced to save lives. By following them, we have the best chance of getting back to normal as quickly as possible.

I would also like to take this opportunity to thank all the key workers in the Moorlands who are doing such a fantastic job and a special thank you to those of you who are helping others. We have that true sense of community spirit here in the Moorlands and I thank you all. We can, and we will, get through this.
